I look forward to seeing you all around the Club.


## GOLF NEWS

### Green Side UP

August was a very challenging month with the relentless amount of rain. We are just now getting a handle on the course being back in shape regarding mowing, weed control, etc. To compound this and other problems, we have been experiencing problems with staffing levels. As anyone who owns a business knows, it is difficult to find labor. We hope to return to normal in the coming weeks.

The lakes have been a mess for some time. After several meetings with our lake maintenance company, there is a game plan to get things cleaned up. In their defense, aquatic weed control is particularly challenging with the volume and frequency of rain that we have experienced over the last six weeks. Hopefully a month from now, we'll be on a path forward.

We have also been dealing with a lack of reclaimed water forcing us to pump out of the lakes. After the County installed a new water meter, they didn't reassemble the pipe properly. This resulted in the pipe blowing apart, putting a hole in the wall of the pump house, and damaging two out of three pumps. We hope to return to irrigating with reclaimed water soon as the County is in the process of repairing our system.

Next month will bring a rosier outlook as we push through a few setbacks this month.




