The major tournament season is ramping up and we have some exciting results to go through. There was a pair of title defenses that should be mentioned first. In the Two Person Match Play Tournament, members **Kirk Barker** and **Dean Johnson** teamed up to win the event for the second consecutive year. Their matches were very tight. They won their first match 2 & 1, the second match went to 19 holes and in the finals, they beat **Doug MacArthur** and **Bruce Narcisi** 1 up. The Ladies' Individual Matchplay was dominated again by **Louise Dale** winning both her semi-finals and her finals matches 5 & 3. **Teresita Long** was the runner-up to Louise this year. The Cunningham Cup was held on January 22nd and 23rd with back-to-back days of temperatures that barely touched 50 degrees and rain and wind. Despite the terrible weather, all 36 players showed both days in support of **Jared Bailey** the White Hat team captain, and **Cory O'Hanlan** the Black Hat team captain. The Black Hat team opened day one with an incredible seven-point lead and never looked back. Green Side UP

After a beautiful December and half of January, the weather has gotten cold. As a result, the grass has gone to brown and soon dormant. This is the time that cart traffic will start beating us to death. I want to again remind everyone that carts damage the grass year-round. In the winter, it kills it, leaving us to scramble in the summer to recover. A few simple habits make a big difference:

1. Never follow the beaten path. Choose your own.
2. 90 degrees to your tee shot.
3. Get back on the path once your ball is within 50 yards of the green.


You may have noticed we started redoing the fairway bunkers, starting at 11. It has turned into a bigger project than anticipated because of the years of accumulated left-over sand. To do as properly within budget, that old sand has to be removed until we get to the hard soil beneath.

Otherwise, the old sand will eventually work its way to the surface, muddling the new white sand. We are also installing new drainage to keep them dry in the summer.

Because of the excess amount of sand to remove, we are exploring building target greens on the driving range. Fortunately, I decided to add irrigation there with our new system two years ago to allow for projects such as this and other and other possibilities.


