Green Side UP

November marks the time when our nighttime temperatures begin to drop and growth of our Bermuda and paspalum turfgrasses slows down. Traditionally, this is also the time that we put out our winter ryegrass seed. Like last year we will be overseeding tees only. The winter ryegrass on the tees allows for quick recovery from divots and traffic during our busiest time of the year on the most concentrated areas of traffic. The downside of overseeding with winter rye is that we are introducing another plant that will compete with the existing summer turfgrass for light, water, and nutrients over the winter months. This competition leaves the turfgrass a little weaker at the end of the winter season. For this reason, we chose to not overseed the fairways last season and it resulted in much healthier fairways coming out of winter. I think that we can all agree that the fairways are as full and healthy as ever. We anticipate that this strategy will lead to continued improvement in the coverage and health of our fairways in the future.
