March is Club Championship month here at Seminole Lake Country Club and this is what you need to know to get involved. The Senior/ Super Senior Club Championships are open to all golf members and will be held on Saturday, March 4th, and Sunday, March 5th. You must be 55 or older to play in the Senior Championship, in which the men will play from the white tees and the ladies will play from the teal tees. The Super Senior Championship is for members over the age of 70 and will be played from the red tees by the men and the teal tee by the ladies. The Club Championship is open to all golf members and will take place Friday, March 24th through Sunday the 26th. This will be played from the red tees for the ladies and a modified black tee for the men. Both events have gross and net flights, so a valid USGA handicap is required to enter the net portion of the tournament. Make sure to call or stop by the golf shop to sign up. Also upcoming is the WGA Ladies' Member/Guest Tournament on Tuesday, March 28th, and the Men's Member/Guest on Saturday, April 1st.

We had a great turnout with 56 members participating in the Men's and Ladies' Member-Member this year. Last year team **Carolynne Smith** and **Diane Sargent** came back from last place after day one to tie for first place in the tournament. This year they took a much easier path to winning. They held a one-shot lead after day one and on day two shot an incredible 101 to win by 13 shots! Congratulations on the back-to-back wins. They will have a big target on their back next year. The men's flight was much closer and went to a playoff between teams **Steve Webber/Jim Rosenberg** and **Mack Long/Jim Rowland**. On the first playoff hole, **Jim Rosenberg** lagged his 60-foot putt to about four feet before his partner Steve made a 10-foot putt for par making Jim's putt good. Unfortunately, Jim Rowland missed a short par putt so Jim and Steve won the event. 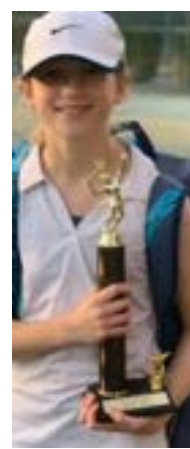

Notice Regarding Seasonal and Annual Golf Memberships

Entering our peak season, our golf membership was full with both Annual and Seasonal Golf members. Since December we have maintained a waiting list for those who wish to become Annual Golf members. Beginning March 1, 2023, our current Seasonal Golf members who have met their 3-month Seasonal Golf dues minimum will have an opportunity to convert their memberships to Annual Golf or Annual Full memberships if they choose. Those who have yet to meet their 3-month Seasonal Golf dues minimum, may indicate their intention to convert their membership to Annual Golf or Annual Full upon reaching their minimum and a space will be reserved for them.

On April 1, 2023, we will open the memberships up first to any current Social or Tennis members who have been members since before January 1, 2023 and then to those non-members who wish to join as Annual Golf members. Whatever Golf memberships are not full with Annual Golf members as of October 1, 2023 will be made available as Seasonal Golf memberships for the 2023/2024 season. There is no guarantee that there will be Seasonal Golf memberships available for the 2023/2024 season. To protect the integrity of the memberships and afford members greater access to tee times, non-golf members will be restricted to no more than two rounds of golf per month during certain times of the day and times of the year.
