Sean will begin this week mowing these at gradually lower heights of cut over the coming weeks. We will play these areas as ground under repair with mandatory free relief not nearer the hole. COURSE NEWS

April has been a warm and productive month for growing grass, despite the abnormally low rainfall. Things are starting to line up regarding our upcoming greens re-grassing beginning June 12. The first step is removing the existing grass, and planting it throughout the golf course. Some will be used around the greens to correct weakened bunker edges and collar areas that aren't up to standards. The majority of #10 tee will be re-sodded, along with #2 green tee, #16 red tee, and #5 white tee. Most of the remaining bad areas in 8 Fairway and rough will be regressed. In general, we should have enough sod to address most, if not all, remaining bare areas.

After that, we replace the needed soil with amendments and fertilizer. Then we rototill and reshape the green to its original shape. Once that's done we'll be able to plant the new sprigs.

Besides our start date, it's impossible to provide a strict timeline on how quickly things will happen. Weather and labor are factors I can't predict. Our goal is to have the sprigs planted by the first of July. Once the sprigs are planted, we're expecting to re-open the greens roughly 75 days later, therefore, our goal is to re-open the greens by September mid-September.

As many have already noticed, one of our crew members has been missing. Due to my living situation, I had to give up Moxie for a new home.

He now resides in the neighborhood with a good friend of mine. His dog has been Moxie's best buddy since day one. In short, he's in a great home with people who love him. He may make an appearance from time to time, once he's settled into his new home.
