
CLUB NEWS



COURSE NEWS

We are continuing to complete projects around the course, and again I'd like to express my thankfulness to the maintenance crew for their hard work. Trees and shrubs have been pruned back. Bridges have been rebuilt and painted, and mulch spread around trees and beds. We have expanded and relevelled the forward tee on #2 which should be playable in the next couple of weeks.

Currently, we are working on smoothing cart path edges, edging bunkers, and plugging some of the thin areas on greens. We've been spraying herbicides for weeds and spraying insecticides for mole crickets and nematodes.

Recently we applied our spring fertilizer along with a pre-emergent weed control. As many of you know, we brought in a bulk spreader to make the spread. The truck with an onboard computer and GPS allows the operator to calibrate the system to set a precise spread rate. The uniformity ensures the product is spread evenly and accurately without overlap. The pre-emergent applied will help control a wide array of various broadleaf and grassy weeds through spring and summer. If you're wondering about a weed and feed for your home yard, now is a good time. Be sure to read and follow the label.

In April we welcome the arrival of spring and warmer nighttime temperatures. With that, we expect a flush of turf growth in the fairways and greens which have lain dormant for the last few months. The El Niño winter has brought cooler-than-normal temperatures along with unusually high winter rainfall and added cloud cover robbing us of sunlight in the months when we need it most. All of this is to say we are happy that spring is here.
