Hurricane Helene Update:

The Club was hit hard by Hurricane Helene. The golf and tennis clubhouses were spared of any serious damage but the lower cart barn and the maintenance facility were submerged in about 3' to 4' of water. About half of the cart fleet was lost to the saltwater along with several mowers, utility vehicles, and the beverage cart. We are working now on replacing the damaged carts with temporary rentals. Until that time, there may be some blocks of tee times available only to walkers. Trust that we are doing all that we can to get the temporary fleet here as soon as possible.

More than half of the golf course and all of the tennis courts were flooded with saltwater backing up the bayous and canals. Our staff have all been working exceptionally hard to get our facilities reopened. The golf course and all of the tennis courts are now open for play. We are still dealing with the tremendous volume of debris around the whole property but hope to have it all removed within the next couple of weeks.

One of the issues that we are concerned with is flushing the salt out of the soil. To that end, we will be irrigating a fair amount over the next week or so. So if you are thinking that the last thing we need on the golf course is more water, that is the reason.

We are wrapping up the locker room projects. We plan to have the locker room facilities reopened by October 15th in time for the Member Appreciation Night. We sincerely look forward to seeing everyone here and welcoming our members into the new spaces.
